


Racial Wealth Gap Learning Simulation

Sat., Jan. 17, 10-11:30am Soup & Bread Potluck Childcare available Open to age 13 & up

This simulation is an interactive tool that helps people understand the connections among racial equity, hunger, poverty, and wealth. It is a good first step for people unaware of structural inequality, a support tool for those who want a deeper understanding of it, and a source of info for experts who want to know the quantifiable economic impact of each policy that has widened today's racial hunger, income, and wealth divides. In the simulation, participants learn how federal policies created structural inequalities—property ownership and education are just two among many areas affected—and how these policies increase hunger and poverty in communities of color. Participants will gain an understanding of why racial equity is so important to ending hunger and poverty in the U.S. and be inspired to support policies that undo and/or reduce disparities.

We Want to Count YOU as a Member!

Each January, every UU congregation counts its voting members and reports the number to the Unitarian Universalist Association. We begin the process early in January and report our total on Feb. 1. Our church's bylaws state that people will be counted as voting members if they... "(1) have been members of the church for 28 days or more and (2) are members of a pledging unit having a financial contribution of record within the current or previous calendar year. This financial requirement may be waived by the minister in consultation with the President of the Board of Trustees for persons who are unable to contribute."

Unmarked cash gifts to the Share the Plate offering are much appreciated but leave no "contribution of record" since the source of the cash cannot be identified. If you are a member who only contributes through the unmarked loose offering, please put your donation in an envelope with your name on it next Sunday. We want to count you!



Form a Crowd, Stay Loud: Whistles & Instructions Available at UUCP

UUCP has received a donation of whistles. Along with a small instruction booklet, they are on the church history case near the front door. The whistles are meant to warn people that ICE

(Immigration and Customs Enforcement) is in the area, to bring out neighbors as witnesses, and to amplify the sound as a warning to others.

The instructions for whistles are very simple:

- If you see ICE in the area, blow short bursts on the whistle.
- If they're actively snatching someone, long

These instructions are in a one-sheet, eight-page zine made by Chicago's Pilsen Arts & Community House that has become the visual symbol of the movement.






